ORDINANCE NO. 420

An Ordinance of the Town of Coupeville declaring an emergency in the General Fund and setting forth the amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, as follows:

SECTION 1: There is hereby declared to be an emergency in the General Fund within the Police Department for the expenditure of funds for an unappropriated expense for the purchase of a new radar unit which could not have been foreseen at the time of the making of the estimates for the annual 1987 Budget which requires the expenditures of not to exceed \$3,000.00 not provided for in the annual budget.

SECTION 2: The Town of Coupeville, in the person of the Treasurer-Clerk, is hereby authorized to amend the 1987 Budget reflecting the above expenditure in the General Fund.

SECTION 3: Coupeville Ordinance No. 417 is hereby amended.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the passage by the Town Council and proper posting according to law.
