

An ordinance vacating that portion of Center Street adjacent to Lots 1 and 2, Block 12 of the Plat of Coupeville.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington has passed a resolution initiating proceedings for vacation petitioned by Maryalice and Kenneth Brooks, and has held a Public Hearing on said petition, and the Town Council has determined it is in the public interest to vacate said portion of Center Street, and it will relieve a hardship imposed upon the adjacent property caused by the platting of Coupeville.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. That the East nine (9) feet of Center Street adjacent to and abutting upon Lots 1 and 2, Block 12 of the Plat of Coupeville in Section 33, T.32N. R.1E.W.M., Island County, Washington, is hereby vacated and title to the vacated portion of right-of-way shall belong to the abutting property owner.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon proper posting and recording with the Auditor of Island County, Washington.
