

TOWN OF COUPEVILLE

ORDINANCE NO. 436

An Ordinance separating the office of treasurer and the office of clerk and repealing any and all ordinances in conflict thereof.

WHEREAS, RCW 35.27.200 provides for the abandonment of consolidation of the office of town treasurer with the office of town clerk.

WHEREAS, the Town of Coupeville by Ordinance 96, dated March 9, 1954, combined the office of clerk with that of treasurer.

WHEREAS, it is no longer in the best interests of the Town to retain the consolidation of the office of clerk with that of treasurer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Coupeville:

Section 1. That Ordinance 96, dated March 9, 1954, and any and all ordinances mandating the consolidation of the office of clerk and the office of treasurer are hereby repealed, and the consolidation of the office of treasurer and the office of clerk shall be terminated effective midnight December 31, 1989.

Section 2. The office of treasurer shall be an elective office. The clerk shall be appointed by the Mayor and may be removed at his or her pleasure.

Section 3. The treasurer and the clerk shall separately exercise all powers and perform all the duties required by statute or ordinance for their respective offices.
