



## COUPEVILLE COMMUNITY GARDEN

The Town of Coupeville sponsors a Community Garden for residents of Coupeville.

The garden is located at Highway 20 & Broadway between the forest & the Living Hope Church. If you are interested in renting one of the 60 plots for organic gardening, please complete and return this application with your payment of \$30.

Our community garden will be open year-round. Please note that areas of the garden are prone to flooding. Winter gardening is at your own risk. Garden plots are 10' x 12', and the rental fee of \$30 per plot is payable with this application. Garden plots will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Returning gardeners may request their prior year plot. Requests for multiple plots will be honored as long as space is available. If space is available, plots may be rented by residents outside of the town limits.

## COMMUNITY GARDEN

### RULES & RESPONSIBILITIES

1. The Town of Coupeville Community Garden Program is an organic gardening program. Use of pesticides, herbicides and insecticides made from synthetic materials as well as use of chemical fertilizers are strictly forbidden. Only non-toxic slug bait is permitted. Use of raw human or animal waste is not allowed. For information on organic fertilizers and pest control call the Master Gardener hotline at 360-639-6058.
2. Gardeners are responsible for cultivating, weeding, fertilizing, watering, litter pickup and all other care for their plots. Illegal plants and plants on the state's Noxious Weed list are not allowed. Please see the Washington State Noxious Weed list on their website: [www.nwcb.wa.gov/printable-noxious-weed-list](http://www.nwcb.wa.gov/printable-noxious-weed-list).
3. The town provides three water faucets within the garden. Individual hoses and sprinklers must not be left hooked up to these faucets. Doing so could result in overwatering onto a neighbor's plot, forgetting to turn off the hose, and keeping other gardeners from using the faucet. Gardeners need to provide their own tools and watering cans. Please conserve water as much as possible, by watering in the morning & evening and not during the heat of the day. Tools, supplies, seeds, etc. left in the garden shed are for communal use. Please return them to the shed when finished.
4. Garden Plots are to be used for recreational gardening and for growing vegetables, flowers and herbs for personal or family use. Commercial growing is not allowed. Marijuana grown for personal use is not allowed. Any extra food grown may be shared or donated to the Gifts from the Heart Food Bank. No permanent plants, plants over 4ft. tall, or plants that infringe upon or shade another gardener's plot. Please do not intrude on neighbors by over watering or engaging in other non-respectful behavior.
5. Paths must be kept free of debris, tools and equipment. No motorized vehicles are allowed on site.
6. Place dead plant material in the designated compost and weed areas. Gardeners are responsible for removing other trash from the site.
7. Dogs, cats, and other animals are NOT allowed in the gardens at any time.
8. Smoking and music without earphones are not allowed.
9. Parking is only permitted in the designated parking strip. No overnight parking is permitted. Vehicles may be in the parking area only when the gardener is present. Please do not park in church lot.
10. Gardeners who fail to follow the rules will receive a written warning. A secondary breach of rules will result in termination of the gardener's plot privileges. No refund will be given.
